The PE and Sports Premium aims to support a measurable and sustainable improvement in school PE and sports at Larkfields Infant School. This is underpinned by high quality teaching that increases participation levels in physical activity and will lead to healthier pupils who are engaged across the whole curriculum.

Key Achievements- to date

- ✓ Introduced Children to new physical activities of yoga, fencing and archery.
- ✓ 73% of Children attended an after-school sports club.
- ✓ Active PE and Express Coaching have continued teaching staff's CPD in PE.
- ✓ Successful Sports day where all children are active throughout and have the chance to work within a team competitively.
- ✓ Popular Active days allow us to introduce new sports and promote a healthy lifestyle. New Sports introduced so far have been- ice skating, rock climbing, golf, kick boxing and an army assault course.
- ✓ Visits from CO OP healthy eating team and Olympians
- ✓ Attendance at a variety of inter school sports day and competitive events such as chance to dance and inclusive sports.

- ✓ Express coaching delivered high quality PE lessons to all children.
- ✓ Express coaching delivered and supported MSA team to create more active lunchtime activities.
- ✓ Attendance at 2 inter school sports festivals.
- ✓ 68% of children attended at least 1 after school sports club
